



Lee Terry on the issues:

ILLEGAL IMMIGRATION

Many Americans have concluded that the Federal Government is not serious about stopping immigrants from illegally entering our country. While the president is right that you cannot totally secure the borders, we can do a whole lot more than what is currently being done.

Illegal Immigration is a matter of national security and we must know who is entering our country, **thus border security has to be the number one priority in any immigration reform effort.** It cannot be an after thought.

Along with border security, I have a three-point plan, as follows:

1. Companies hiring illegal immigrants must receive stronger penalties and enforcement of laws preventing them from hiring illegal immigrants.

3. Revise the current immigration law to allow more non-US citizens to temporarily work as guests in the United States legally. This program would allow manual workers to enter the United States to fill temporary employment needs. Once the job is complete, they must return home. ¹
